#### learner as researcher and theorist

#### on other people's stories

### on my own story

in enquiry (learner research) while gathering material and putting it in useful order

probe an episode, look for influences at critical times

learning to recognise sequences - one thing leading to another

while gatheringmaterial for their own stories

watch for influences and work out what to do about them

learning to recognise who and what they pay attention to - and why

while noting key factors and hunching ho they work

on reflection (learner theory)

share and compare stories about how people deal with 'big moments' in their lives

learning to appreciate other people's viewpoints on career

while anticipating possibilities and planning what to do

probe 'why did I do that?', looking for big influences

learning to recognise what is useful in their experience and the help they receive
